POST-TENURE REVIEW PROCEDURES
September 16, 2005

The procedures for post-tenure reviews are listed below. The criteria for post tenure reviews are the same as the Departmental RPT Criteria for promotion to the same rank.

1. Tenured Associate Professors are reviewed at least once every five years for possible promotion according to departmental RPT guidelines. The procedures listed below apply to full professors with tenure.
2. Post-tenure reviews are to occur every five years after tenure is awarded per PPM (<http://www.admin.utah.edu/ppmanual/8/8-3.html>)
3. The Department Chair shall determine annually which faculty members are to be reviewed.
4. The Policy Board shall assign three-member committees consisting of a chair and two members. All committees shall be comprised of members of the Policy Board who are full professors with tenure.
5. The committees shall write and submit their reviews to the Department Chair by the announced deadline.
